

Glass pearls and super duos team up to make a festive holiday pendant. Suspend it from a chain or a pretty ribbon for a terrific yuletide gift.

Ingredients:

6 Glass Pearls 6mm- Dark Green 6 Glass Pearls 4mm- Cherry Red 30 Super Duo Beads- Dark Green 1 gram 11° Japanese Seed Beads 1 jump ring 18" 6# Fireline 1 needle snips

Key:

6mm GP= 6mm Glass Pearl 4mm GP= 4mm Glass Pearl SD = Super Duo Beads 11° = Japanese Seed Beads PU = Pick Up PT = Pass Through PBT = Pass Back Through JU = Jump Up

Let's get started.

Round One:

PU one 11°, 1 6mm GP, continue alternating for a total of six each. Slide to the end of your working thread leaving a 3" to 4" tail. PBT all the strung beads from the tail to form a circle. Tie the tail thread and working threads together to secure. Exit 11° closest to the knot.

Round Two:

PU one 11°, one SD, one 11°, one SD, one 11° for a total of five beads. Jump over 6mm GP. Anchor by passing through 11°. Continue round until all 6mm GP has an arc of beads.

Round Three:

PT 11° and bottom hole SD. JU through top hole SD to begin this round. PU 1 4mm GP. PT top hole next SD. PU 3 SD. PT top hole next SD. Continue round until all six units are completed.

Adding a loop to attach jump ring:

Weave up to top hole of any center SD on your piece. PU four 11° PBT same hole in SD from the opposite side to form a small circle. Reinforce the circle by PBT all beads.

Finishing:

Weave working thread into piece, tie off. Snip working thread, and tail thread. Open jump ring and attach to small loop. Slip a chain, or cording through the jump ring to make a necklace.
